

## Domestic Violence Understanding and Awareness Training Course Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the Domestic Violence Understanding and Awareness Training course, participants will acquire the following competencies:

- Define Domestic Abuse
- Explain the impact of Legislation including Serious Crime Act 2015
- List Statistics and Prevalence
- Explain the cycle of abuse
- Give an overview of repeat incidents, barriers to leaving and abusive relationship and reporting incidents
- Explain victim (female and male) and perpetrator behaviours/ psychological responses
- Describe the impact on physical health, mental health and the economy
- Explain child protection procedures and the impact of abuse on children
- Describe key risk indicators and dynamic risk assessment, important factors to consider
- Explain the use of DASH Risk Identification Checklist to identify risk assessments
- Give an overview of safeguarding measures (including MARAC), appropriate intervention, how to respond, when and how to refer
- Describe the legal framework for information sharing, The Criminal Justice System and Civil Orders
- Explain roles, responsibilities and strategies available for effective multi agency working through best practice
